## INFORMATION SESSION Changes to Service Provision under the NDIS

You are invited to attend an information session to update you on changes to MEIS' service provision across the region.

With the NDIS roll out well under way we are seeing more children transitioning to the NDIS now. MEIS is working under a different funding model and this has resulted in changes to our service provision. MEIS is also an Early Childhood Early Intervention (ECEI) Transitional Provider in this region until July 2018. In this role we will accept and manage referrals for new children.

We are aware of the general lack of information and confusion in the community about what the changes really look like and how these might affect you. We are keen to collaborate with you in the best way to support the children's learning, social participation and inclusion both in your settings and the general community.

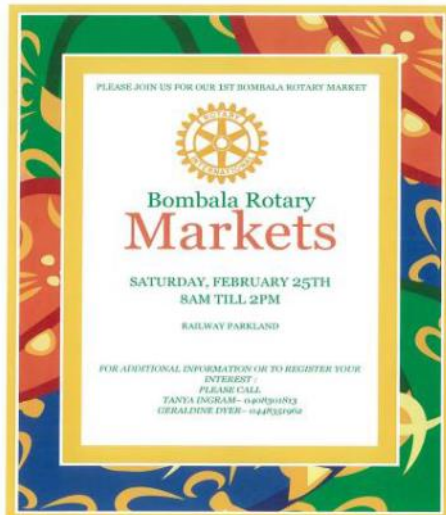
