On Tuesday we had approximately 40 students in attendance for the ANZAC Day March. The children did a fantastic job at representing our school and a special thanks to our school leaders for the laying of the wreath and leading of the march.

Thank you to all parents for ensuring their children were in the correct uniform for school photos. We looking forward to seeing the end product very soon.

After consultation with staff, we have decided to modify the afternoon processes to ensure a smooth and safe transition from school to home.

Students will now assemble behind the school building of an afternoon and line up in allocated areas.
